The Palm Beach Civic Association's annual meeting will feature Mayor Gail Coniglio's State of the Town address and the presentation of the annual Kunkel Awards by the Raymond J. Kunkel Foundation.

The meeting will begin at 10 a.m. Monday at the Flagler Museum.

The Raymond J. Kunkel trustees will honor five individuals and one organization that have made significant impacts on Palm Beach.

They include:

- Leslie Evans, resident, business owner and local attorney, for his leadership in the campaign to help renovate the historic Paramount theater building on North County Road, which is owned and managed by the Paramount Church.

A check for \$1,000 in his honor will be given to the Paramount renovation fund.

- Bill and Betsy Raper, for their dramatic rescue of victims of a boating disaster in the Intracoastal Waterway last summer.

They will receive a check for \$2,000.

- Palm Beach's Mobile Eyes and Yvonne Beroud and Felix Baptiste for heroic actions. The Scott Lewis Landscaping employees had received training in the Mobile Eyes public safety program, a police and public works partnership for people who work outdoors in the community. Police were able to arrest a suspect in Palm Beach when the two reported observing someone take \$1,500 worth of lawn equipment from one of their trucks in town. The two will receive checks for \$1,000 and the foundation will also contribute \$1,000 to Mobile Eyes.

The Kunkel Awards were established in 1976 in memory of Civic Association director and chairman Raymond J. Kunkel.
